

Important Dates for Year 11 Students

Summer Term

- All girls now have access to their examination timetable. Please check this carefully and re-check it. Remember, misreading a timetable is not a valid excuse in the eyes of the examination boards.
- Examinations will start at **9.00am (8.40am registration)** in the morning and **1.00pm (12.40pm registration)** in the afternoon.
- **Study leave** starts on **Friday 14th May** when we hope to have a great day out at **Alton Towers**. Before this date, special arrangements will be made for girls having oral examinations. After this date, girls are welcome to study independently in school or seek help from subject staff by private arrangement. If in school, girls **MUST** sign in and out, to comply with security/safety codes. Pupils must wear full school uniform during any visit to school and when in examinations.
- If ill or unable to attend an examination session for any reason, school must be informed immediately.
- **Sixth Form Induction – Monday 28th June**. All those joining the Sixth Form will be required in school from **8.40am until approximately 12.30pm**. You are not required to wear school uniform.
- **Book Collection** Text books will be collected from each girl prior to her last written examination in each subject. Failure to return a text book is a serious concern and could affect further issuing of text books for Advanced Level.
- **The Year 11 Prom** will take place on the evening of **Tuesday 29th June**.

Work Experience

- Mrs Mason and Miss Burke will continue to help pupils find work experience placements.
- Work experience is important to demonstrate to future employers and university admission tutors that a student is interested in a particular line of work or study.

Results Day

- GCSE Results will be available **between 9.00 and 11.00am on Tuesday 24th August** in the school library. They will NOT be given by phone.
- Examination Board printed copies of these results will be available for collection between **10.30am and 12 noon on Thursday 26th August**. Any which are not collected by this time will be posted to a pupil's home address.
- On this day, **Thursday 26th August**, senior members of staff will be available to advise pupils about changes to AS option choices, re-marks and requests for scripts.

- Term starts for Sixth Formers on Thursday 2nd September. Prior to this, any student wishing for advice on A Level study may ring the School Office to make arrangements to meet with a Senior Member of staff between GCSE results and the start of term.
