

Scheme of Work – AS/ A2 Classical Civilisation
(OCR (JACT) 3816 / 7816)

The AS Classical Civilisation GCE forms 50% of the assessment weighting of the full Advanced GCE. AS GCE is assessed at a standard between GCSE and Advanced GCE and can be taken as a stand alone qualification or as the first half of the full Advanced GCE course.

Assessment is by means of **3 Units of Assessment** for AS and **6 Units of Assessment** for Advanced GCE.

In their **L6th (AS)** year pupils study 3 topics (Greek Art and Architecture is allocated two doubles due to the quantity of material and the Greek Epic and Greek Tragedy 2 modules are taught in the remaining two doubles).

Pupils sit examinations in all three modules at the end of the L6th year (May / June) and can resit these modules in their U6th year the following January or June (or both).

In their **U6th (A2)** year pupils study 3 topics (Greek Art and Architecture is allocated two doubles due to the quantity of material and the Greek and Roman Epic and Greek Tragedy 3 modules are taught in the remaining two doubles). The two literature modules are both synoptic.

Pupils sit examinations in all three modules at the end of the U6th year (May / June).
