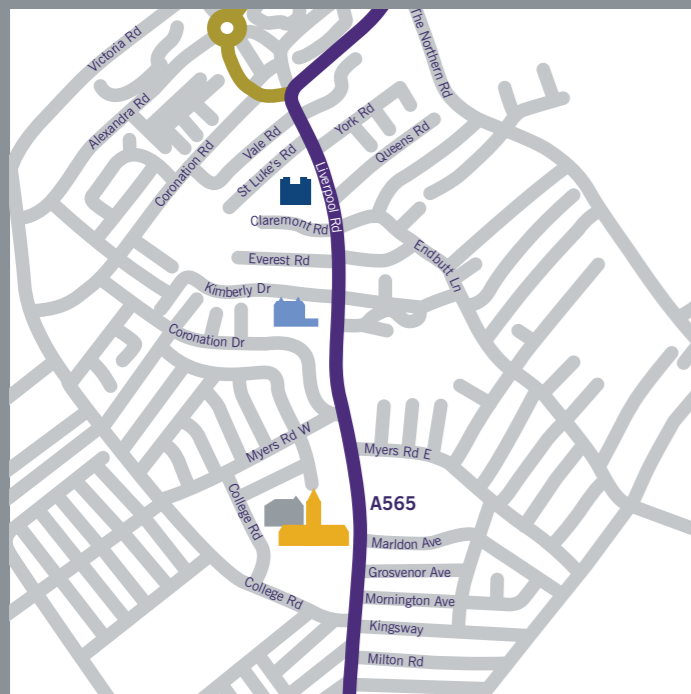

We want our boys to have a passion for learning which goes far beyond the classroom so we offer them opportunities for creative thinking, individual learning and adventure.”

## **Our boys are stretched, not stressed!**

The strong extra curricular programme includes our swimming team who have been unbeaten for the last 8 years, and have reached the National Finals each year for the same length of time.

In Chess the boys reached the national championships and came 7th in the country. In the local competitions one of our boys became the Liverpool Champion with another coming a close second in the runner up position.

The choir have performed regularly to the local community. They have taken part in the Christmas lights occasion in Crosby and performed at old peoples’ homes. In addition, we plan to continue offering free music tuition to all boys in Year 3. John Powell continues to take the Junior Brass Band from strength to strength with over 20 boys playing instruments from cornet down to E flat bass! 2008 has seen a number of major events across the family of Schools to celebrate Liverpool’s Capital of Culture year. The celebrations will finish in December with a spectacular joint concert in Liverpool Cathedral featuring the Junior Boys’ choir.

Rugby and cricket teams had an excellent season with the cricket team only losing once and the rugby team reaching the final of the prestigious Stonyhurst Sevens.

Boys throughout the school are taught French by staff from the Senior School and also attend a French Club before school and during lunchtime.

## **Admissions – Junior Boys, Entry into Year 3**

At this point boys from Stanfield (mixed Infant section of Merchant Taylors’) move to the Junior Boys’ School. Places are also available into Year 3 for external pupils. The boys are invited for assessment in Mathematics and English.

## **Other Year Groups**

Vacancies are sometimes available for entry into other years and tests can be arranged at any time during the year. If a child is successful but no place is available, his name will be placed on a waiting list.
