Activities Day, Friday 2nd July

On Friday 2nd July, over 150 Year 5 pupils will spend a day at the school taking part in various activities.

The beginning and the end of the school day will remain the same, but an alternative timetable will take place for the school as follows:

- Year 7 History Trip to Conwy.
- Year 8 Rehearsals for the Drama Festival.
- Year 9 Rehearsals for the Drama Festival.
- Year 10 Geography / Maths (lunchtime - Spanish students to Tapas, Waterloo) followed by Languages / Physics.

All members of the Lower Sixth will be in school, assisting the various activities taking place throughout the day. These girls will be allocated duties in advance so that they can liaise with the appropriate members of staff.

In addition, the school timetable will be suspended between Monday July 5th and Thursday July 8th (inclusive), to facilitate both the Drama Festival (Years 8 – 9 and Lower Sixth) and extended, creative cross-curricular activities. Off site activities include:

Monday July 5th Year 7 to Liverpool Museum, Year 10 Art exploration in Crosby locality.

Tuesday July 6th Year 10 to Crosby Civic Hall for an author talk.

The end of year Thanksgiving Service will be held on Wednesday July 7th, at 2.30pm. Girls will walk to St Nicholas's Church Blundellsands, accompanied by staff and members of the sixth form. If you wish to attend, please advise the School Secretary Mrs Regan, so that we can ensure that sufficient seating will be in place.

Again, the timings of the school day will remain the same during the alternative timetable days and we hope this will provide the girls with an opportunity to develop creative skills collectively, outside the usual boundaries of practicality!
