**YEAR 8 GEOGRAPHY FIELD EXCURSION**

A Geography field excursion has been arranged for all members of Year 8 on **Wednesday, 21<sup>st</sup> April 2010** to the Yorkshire Dales National Park, visiting White Scar Caves near Ingleton and walking on Ingleborough. The excursion will leave School by 8:50am and return at **approximately 5:30pm**. The cost will be £21.00 per pupil.

School uniform will not be worn but clothing **must** be sensible and suitable for outdoor work. It **must** include trousers (**not** jeans) and a waterproof outer garment **with a hood**. Footwear should be flat and substantial and socks **must** be worn. Girls are encouraged to dress in layers of clothing e.g. Tee-shirt, shirt and sweater, as weather conditions can change quickly. Waterproof trousers would be an advantage.

Each girl should also bring a packed lunch for the day, a clipboard and a large see-through plastic bag. Pencils and biros are essential. Cameras are encouraged but remain the responsibility of your daughter throughout the day. If your daughter is likely to be travel sick please provide her with the appropriate medication beforehand. `I-pods may be brought on this occasion but will not be allowed in the field.

The girls will be completing a project on this work which will comprise 20% of their examination paper.

We trust that, with your daughter's co-operation, the day will prove both valuable and enjoyable and ask you to complete the slip below and return it to School as requested.
