Dear Parents

The Classics Department are planning a visit to the World Museum Liverpool and the Walker Art Gallery. The trip is designed to expand upon the mythology topics covered in Classics during Year 7 through both painting and sculpture. It is an excellent opportunity for your daughter to witness the impact that Classics has had upon the artistic world. The trip will also look at the Tudor period and the Natural World, which are both topics covered by the History and Science departments respectively. It is our intention that every girl in Year 7 should attend this trip.

The visit will be on **Monday 5th July 2010**, and the total cost for the trip will be £5.00. This sum of money will be added to your next bill as a separate fee. If your daughter does not attend the trip, unfortunately it will not be possible to refund the monies.

All girls are expected to wear their school uniform and demonstrate impeccable behaviour at all times. There will be a school lunch provided and the girls should not need to bring any money with them. However, there will be an opportunity for the girls to visit the shop or to purchase an ice cream, so they may wish to bring a small amount of change if needed (we suggest that this change be in coins, to avoid an excessive demand on the museum shop staff to provide change).
