## **About the School:**

Merchant Taylors' School, founded in 1620, is an independent day school with 650 boys in the Senior School (160 in the Sixth Form) and 150 between the ages of 7 and 11 in the Junior School. Admission is by entrance examination and the school is oversubscribed. Academic standards are high and there are excellent facilities for sport, music, art and drama.

The school enjoys a sizable endowment income which is used to assist families with fees and which helps to ensure that the school is not only academically selective but also socially comprehensive.

Situated in Crosby, to the north of the city, the school enjoys close links with the universities of Liverpool. We have attractive playing fields beside the main buildings and more extensive ones at Hall Road, some 5 minutes' drive away.

There is an indoor heated swimming pool, a purpose-built weight training area, tennis courts and all-weather AstroTurf playing area. In addition, the school has purchased a share in the international standard AstroTurf hockey pitch at the nearby Northern Club, and recently opened the state-of-the-art Ian Robinson Sports Centre.

## **THE POST**

Merchant Taylors' School, Crosby seek to appoint a well-qualified and enthusiastic French Language Assistant to join our Modern Foreign Languages Department from September 2018.

- The role will involve delivering conversation/ speaking lessons to mainly KS4 and KS5 pupils although some KS3 classroom support for oral; work will be required at the boys' school.
- The role of the assistant (e) to ensure that the pupils are prepared for all aspects of the GCSE and A level oral tests (we use the AQA specifications for both A level and GCSE).
- The assistant (e) will liaise closely with the MFL staff who will offer guidance over the lesson content.

The post will be term time only and it is hoped that their contract will run from September to the end of the summer term.
