


"It's a buyer's market"

Proportion of placed English 18 year olds with A levels who are predicted/ attain ABB+ from top three grades.



65% predicted ABB+ in 2016

42% achieved ABB+ in 2016, the gap between predicted and achieved is the largest recorded.




