Results should be collected by the student, in person, unless an alternative has been agreed in advance and I.D. will be checked. Results will not be given out over the phone under any circumstances.

New for this year, results will also be emailed to the student's school email address after midday. Please note however that with reformed examination students will only get their grades and not their marks unless they come into school.

**Following results: Review of Marking and Access to Scripts** are available for papers following an unexpected examination result. Costs have spiralled recently but will be refunded if a "grade" is amended.

Please note that marks can go down as well as up following a review, so if you are close to a lower grade boundary it may not be advisable as you could end up with a lower grade. Always seek advice from your teachers prior to any request.

Do familiarise yourself with the services available. You will find a simplified flowchart of the services routinely taken by candidates on the website together with the deadlines for applications.

There are other services available such as clerical checks which we do not routinely recommend. Priority review of marking for GCSEs is also offered by Pearson. Do ask should you want something else your examination board offers.
