Re. Geography Fieldwork to Malham, Yorkshire Dales

A fieldwork visit to Malham, has been organised for all Year 9 pupils. The purpose of the fieldwork is to study the weathering of Carboniferous Limestone and the features that are produced by it. We will also be considering the problems caused by humans in the landscape and village of Malham.
