Ensure good housekeeping within all areas of public consumption and record appropriately.

In the absence of the Duty Manager perform all necessary administration duties such as taking payments and recording the attendance of subscribed members.

Conduct regular visual checks of all areas looking for unusual practice, damaged items or structural defects, and lost property.

Liaise closely with Sports Centre Management regarding membership, booking enquiries and health and safety practices.

To deliver multi sports sessions and children's sports parties for children aged 4-11 years.

To liaise professionally with all visitors to the Sports Centre.
