REMINDER - Please remind Year 11 and Year 13 boys to return library books before they go on exam leave. Textbooks should be returned on the day of their last exam. After this date, bills will be sent home for the replacement cost.

All year 11 and year 13 form teachers have given boys passwords for their library accounts. They can access their own library account through an app, on mobile devices, and check which books they need to return after their exams. Many textbooks are issued through the library system. These barcoded books need to be returned to the library, and not to departments, so they can be removed from accounts.

Internal examinations will take place after half term.

Years 7 to 10 exams will run from Thursday 7th to Tuesday 12th June.

Lower Sixth exams will run from Monday 4th to Tuesday 12th June. There will be study leave for the Lower Sixth during the internal exams and then they will return back to lessons on Wednesday 13th June until the end of term on Wednesday 11th July.
