We wanted to keep you updated about the fundraising events that have taken place to date, stating how much money was raised and how it is being spent.

## **RECENT EVENTS**

We held the first ever **Pumpkin Patch** in October, which raised £322. The rain clouds opened just before picking up time, but it didn't dampen the children's spirits or the time taken to select that very important pumpkin!



The Christmas Fair was held on Friday 1st December at Stanfield and was extremely well supported by children, parents and, Father Christmas who made a very special appearance on his musical sledge. As part of the fair we organised a raffle with first prize being a £250 Liverpool One voucher, second prize a Kindle and third prize a restaurant voucher: there were also many more fabulous gifts. Together the fair and raffle raised just over £2800.



We also held our first ever Christmas Pop Up Shop for Year 6 and under. This was another hit with the children. Each gift had been paid for in advance and all presents were pre-wrapped and labelled. The children were then able to take home their gifts and hide them under the tree. This raised £1338; we had a huge proportion of gifts donated which meant expenses were extremely low.

Due to the success of the Christmas Pop Up Shop we organised another one for **Mother's Day**. Again, another new venture, which was so lovely to run as the children were so happy, once again selecting gifts, which had been prepaid for. Hopefully recipients were happy to receive the gifts wrapped and labelled, chosen by the children. This raised £626.



Join us at the next meeting Throughout the year the PTA also runs Macmillian Coffee mornings and have held raffles in support of Macmillian. These have been supported so well by parents and children and have raised £1446 for this super charity.



Throughout the school year we run nearly new uniform sales, where spare uniform can be bought at a faction of the cost of new. All uniform is clean and in good condition so if your children misplace any of their uniform it is always handy to have a spare, so please feel free to come along and pick up some spares at the next event on 19 June at Stanfield. We look forward to seeing you there! We take donations of old uniform your children might have grown out of all year round so please just hand them into the school receptions and they will be brought to us to sort and put away for the next sale. The uniform sales have this year brought in approximately £3000.



All monies raised from these events go to benefit the children at MTPS and MTGS directly. We were able to help send five girls to the Model G20 Summit held in Boston Massachusetts in February, with a donation towards their costs of £2500. We have provided funding towards a Shakespeare Workshop for year 6 pupils totalling £1000. We have also booked a Circus Day on the 9th July for every child at Stanfield. The children will attend workshops and then watch a Big Top Performance; this is costing £2000. We also fund the honours board at MTGS.

Discussions will be held with representatives from MTGS and MTPS over the forthcoming weeks to see seek suggestions from the students for future PTA purchases and projects.
