Cookies

Merchant Taylors' Schools, Crosby (the "School"), puts small files (known as cookies") onto your computer to collect information about how you use our site.

Cookies are used to:

- measure how you use the website so it can be updated and improved based on your needs
- remember the notifications you've seen so that we don't show them to you again

The School does not use cookies to identify you personally.

You will normally see a message appear on the site before we store a cookie on your computer.

Measuring website usage

The School uses :-

Wordpress Cookies (WordFence Security)

Name	Purpose	Duration
wordfence_verifiedHuman	Used to verify if the visitor is a bot or human	1 day
wfvt_*	Tracks a user duration so that the page views can be grouped together	30 mins

Third Party Cookies

First-party cookies are those that we set for www.mechanttaylors.com ; third party cookies are cookies that originate from different websites. We do not control the setting of third-party cookies, so if you are concerned you should check the policy on the third-party website.

An example of a third-party website we use is Google. This is primarily for measuring website usage. Another example of a third-party website we use is YouTube. We have a number of videos on www.merchanttaylors.com and although we own (or have permission to use) them, the video content is actually streamed from YouTube. You may therefore receive a YouTube cookie if you view one of our videos.
