Dear Parent(s) and Guardian(s),

One of the events which we have planned to mark the 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Merchant Taylors' Schools in Crosby is a whole schools photograph, which will take place on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2019. The plan is to assemble every pupil and member of staff from the four Merchant Taylors' Schools and take one group photograph. You will be able to purchase copies of this photograph directly from the photography company, Gillman and Soame – details of how to do this will follow. Such an opportunity is rare, of course, and I hope that your son is excited about being a pupil at the School at this time.

I am sure that your son always dresses immaculately but I ask that you (and they) pay particular attention to their appearance on that day. Shoes should be polished, normal uniform strictly adhered to and hair should be neat and tidy. Jumpers will not be worn for the photograph (although pupils may have them in school on that day if they wish). As many pupils will be climbing steps on a scaffolding stage erected specifically for the purpose, the advice is for them to wear flat shoes.

If, for any reason, your son cannot climb stairs or spend a little time at moderate height, please make this known to their form tutor. Arrangements will be made for them to be in the photograph but closer to ground level.

We hope that all pupils will be in school on that day and will take their place in this historic photograph. If you do not wish your son to be part of the photograph, please inform their form tutor by Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September. If we hear nothing, we will assume that you are happy for your son to be photographed.

2020 promises to be a year to remember. Please take a little time to look at our websites to see the range of events which we are using to celebrate our 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary. I hope to see as many of you as possible at one or more of these occasions.
