##### **PART ONE**

- Committee membership of or being a leading activist within a pressure group which campaigns on charity related issues
- Membership of a committee within an external organisation whose work may be related to the functions of Merchant Taylors' Schools, eg Non Executive Directorships, training organisations etc
- A close family member being employed by Merchant Taylors' Schools
- A close family member being a pupil at Merchant Taylors' Schools
- A close family member being employed by the Charity Commission  
(This is not an exhaustive list)

##### **PART TWO**

#### **Approval/Ongoing Maintenance of the Register**
